Invitation Suite Pricing

All couples receive a main invitation, a details card, and a response card with your contract. Other embellishments and add-ons are priced a la carte based on the pricing listed below. Pricing is subject to change and vary depending on the scope of your project.

Invitation Suite FAQs

What is included in an invitation suite?

All Neer the Creek couples receive a main invitation, a details card, and a response card with your contract. Other embellishments and add-ons are priced a la carte.

What is your pricing?

Pricing for a classic invitation suite starts at \$1,250 for the painting, digitization, and design work. Printing costs, envelopes, embellishments, and assembly are all additional costs.

Because each project is so individualized based on the couple's needs, pricing varies greatly. Prices are also subject to change based on the scope of your project and based on the current cost of supplies.

How many revisions are included?

Three rounds of revisions are included with your contract. Additional edits may be subject to additional fees depending on the scope of work.

What is your typical turnaround time?

Turnaround time is usually 10-12 weeks from contract signing to project completion but is subject to change. Invitations are usually sent out 6-8 weeks in advance, so I highly recommend reaching out at least 20 weeks before your wedding date to ensure there's enough time to get them to you with ample time to mail.

What does your process look like?

Once I receive your contact form, I'll reach out to schedule a phone consultation to ask additional questions about your

wedding day and overall vision in more detail. Then I'll send you an estimate and contract based on our conversation.

After I've received your signed contract and 50% non-refundable deposit, we'll get started!

I'll send over a digital sketch of the layout of what you'd like included in your suite. With your approval of the sketch, I'll begin painting, digitizing and designing. You'll receive a mockup of your final invitation. Once everything looks good to go, I'll get the printing process started. I'll proof the printed pieces of your suite before shipping them to you.

Do you share digital files?

No, I do not share final digital files or working design files with my clients; however, I will share a mockup of the final invitation suite for you to proof before it goes to printing to make sure everything looks accurate.

Do you have a minimum order amount?

I do not have a minimum order quantity, but I require my clients to order 10% more invitations than needed to account for any damage, ink spots, etc.

Do you have a refund or return policy?

Because my work is so customized, I do not accept returns or refunds. It's my goal to ensure that I communicate the status of your project to you as best as I can by sending proofs, confirming details, and revealing photos of the finished product before I put anything in the mail. If you are unhappy with your order, please let me know as soon as possible during our time working together so I can make it right.

Live Painting Pricing

Acrylic on Canvas

On your wedding day, I'll come on-site to paint a scene of your choice. I use acrylic paint on a gallery wrapped heavy duty canvas. If you don't see a size you'd like listed below, please reach out for a custom quote.

Live Painting FAQs

What does your process look like?

When I receive your inquiry, I'll reach out to you to schedule a phone consultation to hear about your vision for your painting. We'll walk through any timeline details and questions you have ahead of your big day so that I will not have to bother you on the day of your wedding.

How early do you arrive on wedding day?

I'll arrive approximately 3-4 hours before the start of your ceremony to get set up and start painting the background of your scene.

Do you finish your painting on-site?

Yes, I typically finish your live painting while I'm on property at your venue! However, if I (or the couple) feel like there needs to be additional touch ups or details added, I'll finish it up in my studio and mail to the couple.

Can we include any pets or people not in attendance in our painting?

Of course you can! I'll ask for reference photos and any details you'd like me to know during our consultation. Adding pets or people will be an additional cost depending on canvas size.

Watercolor Guest Portraits

Give your friends and family a wedding favor they'll cherish! I paint watercolor portraits on-site during your cocktail hour and reception for your guests to take home at the end of the night.

Guest Portrait FAQs

What does your process look like?

When I receive your inquiry, I'll reach out to you to schedule a phone consultation to introduce myself and go over your event timeline and where you'd like me to set up. We'll walk through any questions you have so that I will not have to bother you on your wedding day!

How early do you arrive on wedding day?

For guest portraits, I usually arrive on site 1-1.5 hours before the ceremony start time to chat with your wedding coordinator and get my table set up.

Do you allow multiple portraits per person?

I kindly ask that guests only allow one painting per person/ couple to ensure that I can paint as many guests as possible throughout the event.

How many paintings can you do an hour?

I can paint one guest portrait (up to 4 people per portrait) in approximately 6-7 minutes. In an hour, I can paint roughly 8-10 guest portraits.

Depending on the couple's preference, I will either stop taking guest photos at a certain time to ensure that I finish all of them on-site or I can finish any guest portraits at home that I did not get to paint at the venue. In this case, I will mail the additional portraits to the couple, and they will distribute to the appropriate guests.

Do you bring additional staff with you?

Yes, I will bring an assistant to help me take photos of the guests and package each portrait once they're dry so that I can paint as long as possible throughout the night.
